- Registered at Mayerthorpe High School for 18/19 school year in grade 7, 8 or 9. Registration package/update form complete.
- Birth certificate on file
- Alberta Health Care card on file
- Competent skater as per the reference recommendation.
- Interview if necessary with students and parents.

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Student Expectations

- Students are expected to follow all of the school rules both on and off campus.
