Job Specification:

Job Duties:

- Assist Pembina West Co-op meat department by cleaning and cutting meats, fish and poultry.
- Cleaning kitchen equipment and utensils.
- Help with prep work, sanitization, and cleaning of department.
- Performs all work in accordance with established policies and safety procedures.

Special Skill Requirements:

- High level of integrity and work ethic.
- Self-starter with the ability to work in a team environment and follow directions.
- Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing
- Willing and able to learn, adapt to change and demonstrate flexibility

Knowledge and Experience Requirements:

- No experience necessary but a willingness to learn and have an interest in the cook trade.

Special Conditions:

- Must be willing to learn the basic skills of the cook trade
- \$15.25-\$16.04 per hour dependent on experience
- Part time hours to be determined by students and Co-op's scheduling.
- Completion of HCS 3000 (HCS 3010 is optional)
- Must be registered as a high school student and 15 years of age or older
